Covenant missionary Randy Bevis spent years in <u>Thailand</u> using his aquaculture background to help villagers establish fish farming to provide a source of income as well as food. "In-Seine" fish farming has become a "New Food Source for the Hungry" in working with fish ponds for sustainable food production.

In April 2015, Randy, a special assignment missionary with the ECC, founded the nonprofit with the vision "Full Nets, Changed Lives." Fish farming has become the fastest growing food production system in the world with roughly 50 percent of fish eaten coming out of fish farms.
