## **Special Missionary Prayer Focus for this week:**

Julio & Katie Isaza, Colombia: Theological Education, Leadership Development; Christian Formation and Discipleship

#### **MINISTRY OVERVIEW**

We partner with the Evangelical Covenant Church of Colombia (FIPEC) in four primary areas: <a href="leadership development">leadership development</a>, <a href="Christian">Christian</a> formation, theological education, and peace and reconciliation equipping pastors, lay leaders, children's ministry volunteers, and youth leaders. The Covenant Youth Association continues to expand their ministry of peace and reconciliation, ("Be Peace, Make Peace") and social projects are working with marginalized or vulnerable communities, including those who have been displaced.

#### **CHALLENGES**

Encouraging children's ministry leaders to connect with one another and participate in mutual learning.

Helping the ministries become more self-sustaining.

#### **PRAYER REQUESTS**

- 1. For the national church, FIPEC, to find ways for the churches to organize, unify and become self-sustaining.
- 2. Pray for youth leaders and children's ministry leaders in Colombia, that collaborative ministry would take place, and resources and tools be shared to strengthen the ministry.
- 3. Pray for Julio who has begun a PhD research program through Oxford Centre for Mission Studies, focusing on biblical peace.
- 4. Pray for our family as we have suffered the loss of Julio's brother in 2023, and most recently the sudden death of Katie's parents in a car accident. Pray for our family as we grieve and for our boys (in school) as they grow into mature teenagers.
